

Copelandia Madagascar

Instructions:

Open the box and remove the contents.

The box contains:

- 1 grow kit
- 1 grow bag
- 1 cup with casing layer

1. **Hygiene is essential.**

Wash your hands thoroughly with soap. Preferably use gloves and, optionally, a face mask.

2. **Preparation.**

Evenly distribute the mineral casing layer over the surface of the substrate.

Use clean gloves or a spatula.

3. **Moistening & activation.**

Place the container inside the grow bag.

Spray the top of the substrate and the inside of the bag generously (do not soak).

Ensure there is enough fresh air in the bag.

Seal the bag with a clip.

4. **Daily maintenance.**

Open the bag 1–2 times a day to refresh the air.

Lightly moisten the inside walls of the bag and the surface to prevent drying out.

5. **Important!**

Once the first fruiting bodies appear — stop spraying.

From that point on, only air exchange (2–3x a day) is needed. Direct spraying can disrupt growth.

6. **Harvesting.**

The structures are ready for harvest after 5–7 days. Gently twist them off at the base.

The ideal moment is when dark spores become visible.

7. **Next growth cycle.**

After harvesting, lightly moisten the surface again from about 10 cm distance.

A small amount of water at the bottom is acceptable — drain any excess later.

The new cycle will start automatically.

Environmental conditions:

• **Initiation phase:**

- Temperature: 21–26 °C

- Humidity: 95–100%

- **Fruiting phase:**

- Temperature: 21–26 °C

- Humidity: 90–95%
